

Club Guidelines for Young Players

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. As a player, you have a big part to play. That is why Lisnagry FC is asking every player to follow and respect a Code of Conduct. Each parent is asked to discuss this code of conduct with their children.

When playing football, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability.
- Play fairly – I will not cheat, complain, or waste time.
- Respect my teammates, the other team, the referee, and my coach/manager.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Shake hands with the other team and the referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I am unhappy about anything at the club (see www.lisnagryfc.com for details of officers).

When supporting football, parents, players & coaches will:

- Always accept referee decisions without complaint.
- Always accept referee decisions without complaint.
- Respect opponents whether we win/lose or draw.
- Respect all players regardless of their abilities.
- Recognise that soccer is for enjoyment first and foremost and is not about winning.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code any/all of the following actions may be taken by the club League or FAI:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my teammates, the other team, spectators, referee, or team manager/assistants
- Receive a formal warning from the club committee. Be dropped or suspended from training
- In very severe circumstances have membership refused or cancelled.

In addition:

- My Club, League or the FAI may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct. The League/ FAI could impose a fine and suspension against my club for individual actions. As a player I am liable to pay any fee from my individual actions.
- Any comments made on Social Media, which are improper, bring the club into disrepute or are threatening, abusive, indecent, or insulting will lead to disciplinary action.
